BY THE GOVERNOR OF PUERTO RICO
A PROCLAMATION

Special Session of the Legislative Assembly: Call

WHEREAS, there are various matters of public interest which require action from the Legislative Assembly;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, by virtue of the authority conferred upon me by the Constitution, do hereby call the members of the Legislative Assembly, to a special session of said Legislative Assembly, to be held on Monday July 28, 1952 at 10:00 A. M. in the Capitol, for the purpose of considering the following matters and adopting adequate measures for the attention of the same.

1. Amendments to Section 5 of Article II and to Section 3 of Article VII of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico.
2. Amendments to the Election Law and necessary legislation to regulate the guarantees to minor parties contained in Section 7 of Article III of the Constitution.
3. Legislation on the Referendum of amendments to the Constitution as required by Article VII of the same.
4. Appropriation of funds for the publication of amendments to the Constitution.
5. To transfer to the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico the building known as 'Asilo de Indigentes' (Indigent Asylum) and its lot, located in Santurce, property of the Capital and to appropriate the necessary funds to compensate the Government of the Capital.
6. To declare the 25th of July of each year a holiday.
7. To authorize the construction and establishing of the system of Irrigation of the Valley of Lajas.
8. To amend Article 7 of Act 241, approved May 8, 1950, known as 'Act for the Regulation and Inspection of Farm Products and Markets'.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused to be affixed the Great Seal of Puerto Rico at the City of San Juan, this twenty-sixth day of July, A. D., 1952.
