A PROCLAMATION

General Pulaski's Memorial Day

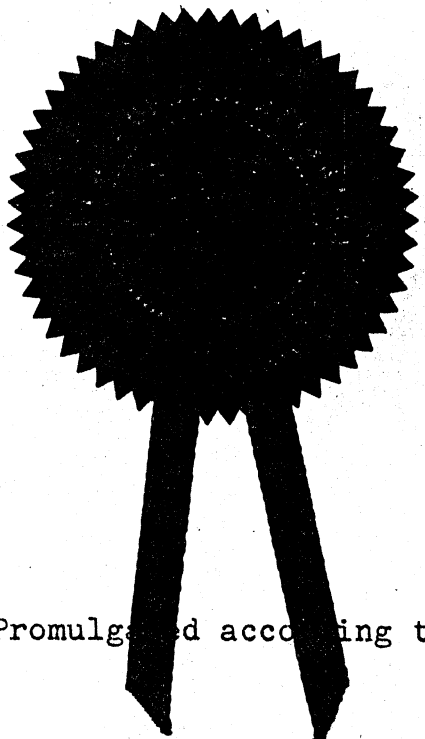
WHEREAS, by Joint Resolution No. 6 of 1935 of the Legislature of Puerto Rico, the Governor of Puerto Rico is authorized and directed to proclaim the 11th of October of each year as "General Pulaski's Memorial Day" in commemoration of the death of the Polish General, Casimir Pulaski, hero of the American Revolution, which occurred on October 11, 1779 while in action at the seige of Savannah, Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of Puerto Rico, do hereby set aside October 11, 1950 as "General Pulaski's Memorial Day", and call upon the officials of the State and municipal governments to display the flag of the Union and that of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico on all public buildings and invite the people of this Island to observe the day in schools and churches, or other suitable places, with appropriate exercises and ceremonies for the observance and commemoration of the death of Brigadier General Casimir Pulaski.
