A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Honorable Harry S. Truman, President of the United States and Honorary President of the National Red Cross has designated the month of March 1952, as Red Cross Month;

WHEREAS, The Red Cross Chapters and auxiliary branches through their programs of instruction on health and safety, considerably help to preserve and increase the health and well being of our people;

WHEREAS, The desinterested and humanitarian work of this institution extending its assistance equally to all, without discrimination to class, is well known;

WHEREAS, This organization must continue to meet the need of servicemen and their families solving their problems at home as well as overseas.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of Puerto Rico, do hereby designate the month of March 1952, the Month of the Red Cross, and urge all my fellow citizens to demonstrate, once more, their sincere christian spirit, by contributing with their utmost liberality toward the American Red Cross Fund, Puerto Rico Chapter, and to offer their maximum cooperation toward the success of the Membership Campaign, in order that this institution may carry out its worthy campaign of public welfare.
