BY THE GOVERNOR OF PUERTO RICO
A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, it is advisable that there should exist an adequate body of volunteers adscript to the Office of Civil Defense, which was organized by the Government for the protection and defense of our population;

WHEREAS, a good system of Civil Defense is not only useful and necessary in times of war or disaster, but it may render daily benefit and service to the community;

WHEREAS, the citizens of Puerto Rico have always distinguished themselves by their disposition to serve disinterestedly the interests of the people;

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Office of Civil Defense to increase the number of its auxiliary volunteers to be able to face an emergency efficiently;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of Puerto Rico, do hereby urge all my fellow citizens, of both sexes, to volunteer their services to the Civil Defense so that said organization may count on the number of auxiliaries that are urgently needed; and I further ask public officials and organizations to cooperate by all possible means with the Office of Civil Defense.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand, and caused to be affixed the Great Seal of Puerto Rico, at the City of San Juan, on this 31 day of March, A. D., nineteen hundred and fifty two.
