A PROCLAMATION

Homage to the Aged

WHEREAS, the Puerto Rico Legislature designated through Act No. 24 of April 27, 1933, the third Friday of April to pay homage to the aged;

WHEREAS, the aged, because of their experience and spiritual serenity are a source of wise counsel and generous orientation for the people that are privileged to have them in their midst;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim Friday, April 18, 1952, as the day to pay homage to the aged this year, and call upon the people to evidence, through adequate acts and ceremonies, their love and veneration to all those persons who have attained a long life surrounded by the affection and consideration to which they are entitled for their works and civic example.
