BY THE GOVERNOR OF PUERTO RICO
A PROCLAMATION

Music Week, 1952

WHEREAS, the National and Inter-American Music Week Committee has requested the Governor to issue a proclamation designating May 4 to 11, as Music Week;

WHEREAS, the usual observance of said week has considerably promoted in Puerto Rico the taste for music;

WHEREAS, music promotes understanding and solidarity among individuals and nations in addition to being an excellent means of spiritual enjoyment;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim May 4 to 11, 1952 as Music Week in Puerto Rico, and call upon my fellow citizens to cooperate in every way to the diffusion and enjoyment of musical art in our Island, particularly during the appointed date.
