A PROCLAMATION

Nurse's Week, 1952

WHEREAS, the Association of Graduate Nurses of Puerto Rico, affiliated with the National Association of the United States, has requested that the week beginning May 12 to 18 be designated as Nurse's Week this year;

WHEREAS, it is fair that nurses should have the opportunity to make known the worthy and humanitarian work they perform as a class, work for which they deserve public recognition and encouragement;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, VICTOR GUTIERREZ FRANQUI, Acting Governor of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim the period of May 12 to 18, 1952, as Nurse's Week, and invite the people to fully cooperate towards the success of such activities as may be carried out during said week.
