BY THE GOVERNOR OF PUERTO RICO
A PROCLAMATION

Press Week, 1952

WHEREAS, by Act No. 126 approved May 6, 1940, as subsequently amended, the Legislature of Puerto Rico set apart, in perpetuity, the week starting the first day of July of each year as Press Week, directing the Governor to remind the people to observe said week; and

WHEREAS, this observance is aimed at stressing the importance of the press in Puerto Rico, so that the public may have a full understanding of what it means for the general progress of the community, and a better appreciation of the worthiness of those who devote their lives to laboring for the collective culture and advancement in the field of a constructive and honest journalism;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of Puerto Rico, do hereby remind all the inhabitants of this Island that the week of July 1 to 7, 1952 has been designated by law as Press Week this year, during which to stress the importance of the press in Puerto Rico, through appropriate acts and ceremonies, and invite all departments and other dependencies of the Insular and municipal governments, as well as all social and civic organizations of the Island, and the people in general to give their enthusiastic cooperation toward the success of such activities as may be held on said week to carry out the purposes of the law.
