BY THE GOVERNOR OF PUERTO RICO

A PROCLAMATION

Enlargement to Call to the Special Session of the Legislative Assembly of Puerto Rico, issued on July 11, 1952, specifying various additional matter to be considered by the Legislative Assembly at the present Special Session.

I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of Puerto Rico pursuant to the provisions of law in force, submit to the Legislative Assembly, for its consideration and appropriate action, the following additional matters:

1. Legislation empowering Section 1 of Article 2 of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, eliminating differences based on birth.
2. To make the necessary arrangements to give publicity to the Legislative procedures in a Diary of Sessions and to appropriate the necessary funds thereat.
3. Legislation related to promulgation of laws, joint resolutions and other official documents, to appropriate funds for the publication of the same and to repeal the provisions of law which by necessity should be repealed for such purpose.
4. Legislation referring to the creation of offices of District Attorney in the Courts of Puerto Rico.
5. To amend Section 2 of Act No. 185, approved on May 15, 1941, as amended by Act No. 8 of March 7, 1946, concerned with the Municipal participation of cigarette tax.
6. To amend Article 11 of Act No. 465 approved May 15, 1947, concerning municipal participation in the profit of the sale of tickets of the Lottery of Puerto Rico.
7. Electoral legislation making possible the nomination or presentation by the political parties of more than one candidate for the same office at the choice of the parties and providing for the establishment of the necessary rules and regulations.
