BY THE GOVERNOR OF  
THE COMMONWEALTH OF PUERTO RICO  
A PROCLAMATION

Enlargement to call to a special session of the Legislative Assembly of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, issued on July 26, 1952 specifying various additional matters to be considered by the Legislative Assembly at the present special session.

I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, pursuant to the provisions of law in force, submit to the Legislative Assembly, for its consideration and appropriate action the following additional matters:

1. To adopt legislation conducive to an increase in the number of Justices in the Supreme Court, pursuant to the provisions of Section 3, Article 5 of the Constitution; and to appropriate the necessary funds.
2. To create the Public Service Commission, and to amend Act No. 70 of December 6, 1917, known as Public Service Act.
3. To amend Act No. 421 of May 14, 1950 known as the Racing Act.
4. To appropriate the necessary funds to meet the expenses of the special session hereby called.
