A PROCLAMATION

Thanksgiving Day, 1952

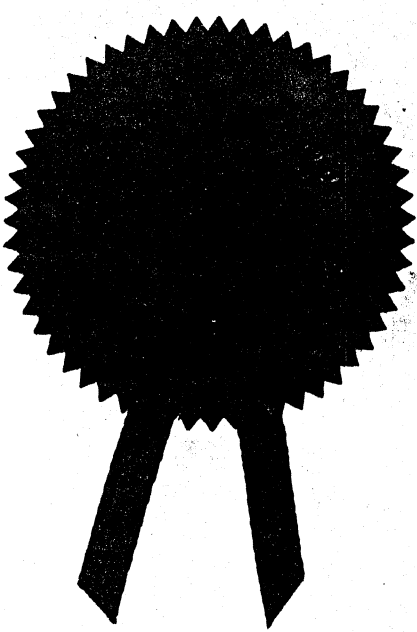
WHEREAS, it is traditional in our country to join our fellow citizens in the continent in the celebration of Thanksgiving Day;

WHEREAS, the President of the United States, considering a Joint Resolution approved by Congress in the year 1941, has proclaimed the coming November 27 as Thanksgiving Day;

WHEREAS, the good people of Puerto Rico have special reasons this year to thank God; since the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico has been constituted and the democratic and christian traditions and practice which govern our collective life have been strengthened;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim the coming Thursday, November 27, as Thanksgiving Day and I urge all my countrymen to pray to God on this date with more devotion than ever, in thanksgiving for His gifts, and to ask Him to strengthen our spirit and to enlighten our way for the great work that we still have ahead of us.
