A PROCLAMATION

Second enlargement to call to a Special Session of the Legislative Assembly of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, issued on July 26, 1952 specifying various additional matters to be considered by the Legislative Assembly at the present special session.

I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, pursuant to the provisions of law in force, submit to the Legislative Assembly, for its consideration and appropriate action the following additional matters:

1. Legislation authorizing Section I of Article II of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico eliminating differences based on birth.
2. Legislation referring to the Seal of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico and to provide the regulations for the use of the same.
