Music Week, 1954

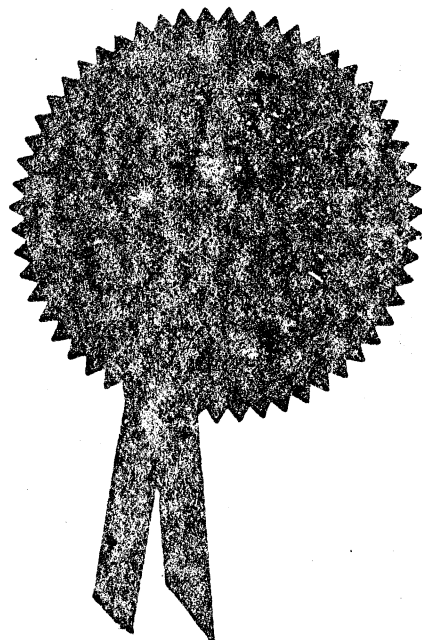
WHEREAS, the habitual dedication of a week to the diffusion and enjoyment of the musical art has considerably promoted in Puerto Rico the taste for such art;

WHEREAS, in addition to its being an exemplary medium of spiritual amusement, music also promotes understanding and solidarity among people and countries;

THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim the days from May 2 to May 9, 1954, as Music Week in Puerto Rico, and exhort my fellow citizens to cooperate through all means at their command to the diffusion and enjoyment of the musical art in our motherland, with special dedication during the days herein designated.
