A PROCLAMATION

Cooperation Week, 1954

WHEREAS, the people of Puerto Rico have adopted the cooperative system as a means to encourage the joint action of its individuals;

WHEREAS, the cooperative movement is one of wide scope in the social and economic life of the inhabitants of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico;

WHEREAS, over 40,000 Puerto Ricans and their families practice at present the precepts of mutual help through cooperative action;

WHEREAS, the public's general welfare demands that the people continue knowing, participating and learning to make more use of the rules of cooperativism.

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim the week of July 3 to 10, 1954, as "Cooperation Week", and urge the people of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico to join the cooperators in exalting this great democratic movement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico to be affixed, at the City of San Juan, this 30th day of June, A. D., nineteen hundred and fifty four.
