A PROCLAMATION

Orientation Day on Heart Diseases, 1954.

WHEREAS, heart diseases constitute the first cause of death in Puerto Rico;

WHEREAS, a third part of the heart patients are children less than twelve years old;

WHEREAS, the Puerto Rico Heart Association is determined to have an educational program on the prevention and ways of treatment of the cardiac ailments, and for the improvement and broadening of the facilities for its diagnosis and treatment;

WHEREAS, the Puerto Rico Heart Association shall launch a campaign to collect funds during the month of July, 1954;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby urge all the inhabitants of this Island to demonstrate their interest in combating heart ailments, by giving their patronage to this campaign, thus helping the Puerto Rico Heart Association to carry through its program. And I further proclaim July 15, 1954, as "Orientation Day on Heart Diseases," urging all public and private institutions to dedicate some time of this day to educate the public on the means of preventing said diseases.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico to be affixed, at the City of San Juan, this 7th. day of July, A. D., one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four.
