A PROCLAMATION

Anniversary of the Establishing of the
Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, 1954

WHEREAS, July 25, 1954 marks the second anniversary of the establishing of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico;

WHEREAS, the celebration of such meaningful event moves to the public merriment and also to a deep and calm rededication to the ideals it serves of democratic human life;

WHEREAS, on that day the people of Puerto Rico firmly maintain, with all their spiritual strength, the gift of their personal and collective freedom in the free political association they have established with the United States;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, in solemnly proclaiming the festivity of this day, urge all the inhabitants of Puerto Rico to attend all the public acts which are to be held in order to renew their devotion to the symbols of our collective dignity and our honorable political association, and to share the general joy in squares, parks and streets, or in the barrios, yards, roads and paths of our countryside, wherever the men, women and children which constitute the good people of Puerto Rico are joined during that day.

at the City of San Juan, this
23 day of July A.D. nineteen
hundred and fifty-four.
