A PROCLAMATION

Air Mail Week

WHEREAS, the Post Office Department in San Juan will observe the week from April 18 to 24 as "Air Mail Week";

WHEREAS, the Post Office Department is closely connected through its air mail service with the growth and development of the air transportation industry;

WHEREAS, the development of air communication service has played a vital role in Puerto Rico's cultural and economic progress;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim the week from April 18 to 24 as "Air Mail Week", and urge the people of Puerto Rico to observe said week by giving their patronage to the air mail services.
