A PROCLAMATION


Children's Health Day

WHEREAS, we should urge all citizens to broaden their knowledge of our children's emotional, social and spiritual development;

WHEREAS, we should all ascertain that children are given the opportunity to develop all aspects of their personality, physical as well as mental, for their individual happiness, and that of their people;

WHEREAS, children's good health is necessary for the development of the productive ability of every country;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUNOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim May 1st. of this year as Children's Health Day; and I entreat all individuals to celebrate on that day acts directed to awaken in our people the interest to carry on a program during the year for the protection and development of the health of Puerto Rico's children, and to urge all citizens to observe this program and to assume the responsibility of striving incessantly until a maximum growth and development are attained.
