A PROCLAMATION

BOY SCOUT WEEK

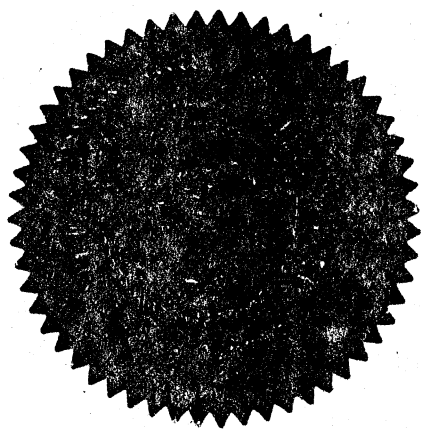
WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts organization has established closely inter-related councils in 57 countries throughout the world;

WHEREAS, said universal organization endeavors to encourage understanding and cooperation among all men, through the making of citizens forever willing to work generously and in good faith toward constructive democratic inter-living;

WHEREAS, the Puerto Rico council of the Boy Scouts of America has proclaimed the period from February 6 to 12 as Boy Scout Week;

WHEREAS, during the Boy Scouts' Forty-Fifth Anniversary celebration, the motto is: "Building for a Better Tomorrow."

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim the period from February 6 to 12, 1955, as Boy Scout Week, and I urge all my fellow-citizens to cooperate toward the success of the activities undertaken by said institution in its aim to promote and preserve that freedom through the ages.
