Week of the Secretary

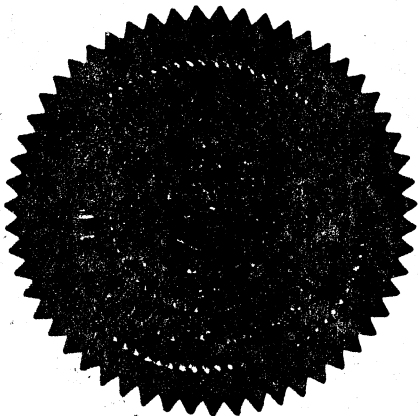
WHEREAS, the Association of Secretaries of Puerto Rico intends to celebrate the week of the secretary during the period from April 24 to 30, 1955;
