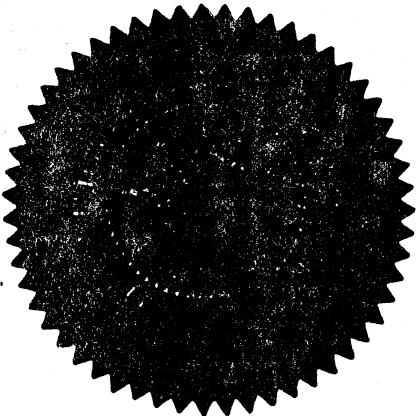

A PROCLAMATION

Teacher's Day, 1955

WHEREAS, Act No. 70 of 1939 declares the first Friday of May of each year as Teacher's Day in Puerto Rico, and provides that the Governor shall issue a proclamation announcing said day and recommending its observance;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ROBERTO SANCHEZ VILELLA, Acting Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby remind the public that Friday May 6th. is the date fixed by law as Teacher's Day this year, and I invite all educational institutions to join in its observance through such activities and ceremonies as may be held on the occasion according to said law.
