A PROCLAMATION

Mothers' Day, 1955

WHEREAS, Act No. 25 of 1915 has set aside the second Sunday in May of each year as Mothers' Day, and provides that the Governor shall remind the people to observe said day;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ROBERTO SANCHEZ VILELLA, Acting Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby take pleasure in reminding all the inhabitants of this Island that Sunday May 8th. is the day fixed by law as Mothers' Day this year, for paying homage to the home and motherhood, honoring the memories of mothers who are dead, and gladdening the existence of those who are still living, by means of demonstrations of love, by appropriate services in churches and other religious and civic organizations, and by wearing the emblematic honeysuckle suggested by our Legislature, as an external manifestation of joy for the sublime ideal being commemorated.
