A PROCLAMATION

Anniversary of the Establishing of the
Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, 1955

WHEREAS, July 25, 1955 marks the third anniversary of the establishing of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico;

WHEREAS, the celebration of such meaningful event moves to public merriment and also to a deep and calm rededication to the ideals it serves of democratic human life;

WHEREAS, on that day the people of Puerto Rico firmly maintain, with all their spiritual strength, the gift of their personal and collective freedom in the free political association they have established with the United States;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ROBERTO SANCHEZ VILELLA, Acting Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, in solemnly proclaiming the festivity of this day, urge all the inhabitants of Puerto Rico to attend all the public acts which are to be held in order to renew their devotion to the symbols of our collective dignity and our honorable political association, and to share in the general joy in squares, parks and streets, or in the barrios, yards, roads and paths of our countryside, wherever the men, women and children which constitute the good people of Puerto Rico are joined during that day.

Juan, this 21st. day of July,
A. D. nineteen hundred and
fifty-five.
