BY THE GOVERNOR OF PUERTO RICO

A PROCLAMATION

Special Session of the Legislature, Call:

WHEREAS, various matters of public interest demand action by the Legislature;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the Constitution, do hereby call the members of the Legislature to a special session which will start on Monday October 24 at the Capitol, so as to consider the following matters, and adopt adequate measures for the attention of same.

1. To review the legislation on minimum wages, and provide funds to the Department of Labor and the Minimum Wages Board for the promotion of this program.
2. New law of duties on articles of use and consumption.
3. To amend articles 2, 9 and 10 of Act 279 of April 5, 1946, known as the Automobiles and Traffic Act.
4. To amend articles 3, 4 and 5 of Act No. 6 approved June 30, 1936, known as the Alcoholic Spirits and Beverages Act.
5. To amend Section 22 of the Act of the University of Puerto Rico, Act 135 of May 7, 1942.
6. To appropriate the sum of \$1,400,000 during the years 1955-56 to 1959-60 to be distributed among the municipalities of Puerto Rico, including the Government of the Capital.
7. To establish a program of conservation and disposition of public documents.
8. Amendments to articles 11, 18, 26 and 29 of the Municipal Law approved on April 28, 1928, and to appropriate funds to carry out the provisions of law.
9. General Law of Corporations.
10. Amendments to the Loan Cooperative Associations Act, Act No. 10, approved July 1st, 1947, with the purpose of increasing the borrowing capacity of the Federation of Credit Cooperatives.

11. To amend Article 3 of the Lottery Act, Act No. 465 of May 15, 1947, with the purpose of authorizing more than two special drawings any one year.
12. To amend Act No. 40 of April 24, 1931 and Act No. 15 of November 27, 1942, related to the duties on gasoline.
13. Legislation authorizing the Government of the Capital and the Municipalities to cooperate with the Department of the Treasury in receiving and collecting the income tax on property within their respective territorial jurisdictions.
14. Appropriation of funds to the Secretary of the Treasury to carry out a survey related to the installation of electronic office machines.
15. Appropriation of funds to the General Court of Justice to put into effect Act #97 of June 23, 1955.
16. Appropriation of funds to the Department of Agriculture and Commerce for the Soil Conservation Program of the Coffee Region.
17. Amendments to Act No. 66 of June 13, 1955 related to the Fund for the Purchase of Shoes for the Students of the Public Schools.
