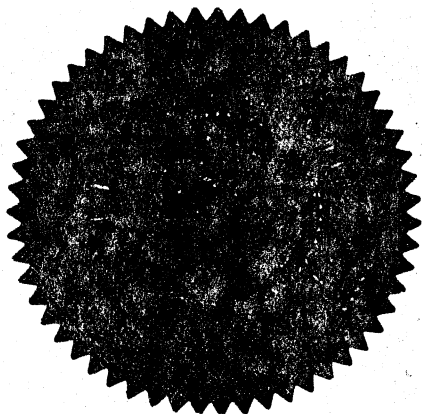
A PROCLAMATION

Special Session of the Legislature. Extension to the Call issued November 18, 1955. Specifying various additional matters for the consideration of the Legislature called to meet on November 21.

WHEREAS various matters of importance to public interests, in addition to those specified in the original Call, demand action by the Legislature at this Special Session;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the Constitution, do hereby submit to said Legislature, for its consideration and action, the following additional matters:

1. Appropriation of funds to the Agricultural Experiment Station.
2. Appropriation of funds to the Department of Labor.
3. To amend Section 12 of the Election Law approved June 25, 1919, with regard to the pamphlets which the General Superintendent of Elections should provide free of charge to the political parties.
