A PROCLAMATION

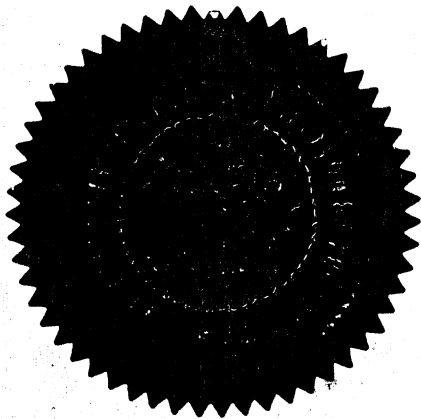
Red Cross Month

WHEREAS, all Red Cross chapters and auxiliary branches, through their programs of education on health and safety, aid considerably in maintaining and improving our people's health and welfare;

WHEREAS, the disinterested and beneficial work of said institution, offering its assistance to all, indistinctively of social class, is well known;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby designate the month of March 1956 as Red Cross Month, and I urge all my fellow-citizens to demonstrate once more their sincere christian spirit by contributing with their utmost generosity to the Red Cross Fund, and by offering their maximum cooperation to the success of the membership campaign, so that this institution may carry out its worthy program of public welfare.
