A PROCLAMATION

Voluntary Services Week

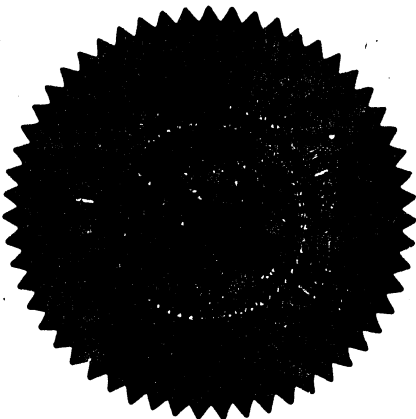
WHEREAS, the Voluntary Services Group of the Veterans Administration has been formally organized for 10 years, and has been performing a task of great accomplishments in its aim of noble and disinterested aid for the rehabilitation of hospitalized veterans;

WHEREAS, these services, rendered indistinctively of race, political beliefs or religious creed, with the sole purpose of performing a necessary service, are a clear indication of the true ideals of brotherhood that should prevail in a democratic society;

WHEREAS, we should encourage the continuous participation of individuals and organizations in these voluntary services;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim the week from April 15 to 21, 1956 as the Voluntary Services Week, and I urge our people to cooperate fully in such worthy task, and to honor the legion of volunteers who so generously have devoted themselves to the rehabilitation of hospitalized veterans.
