A PROCLAMATION

Music Week, 1956

WHEREAS, the customary dedication of a week to the diffusion and enjoyment of the musical art has considerably promoted in Puerto Rico the taste for such art;

WHEREAS, besides being an exemplary medium of spiritual relaxation, music also promotes understanding and solidarity among all people and countries;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim the days from May 6 to 13, 1956, as Music Week in Puerto Rico, and I urge my fellow citizens to cooperate through all means at their command to the diffusion and enjoyment of the musical art in our motherland, with special dedication during the days herein designated.
