A PROCLAMATION

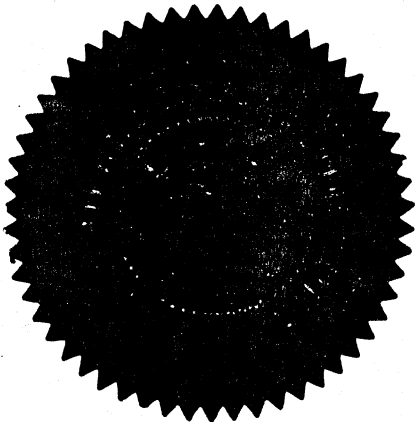
Week of Home Demonstration Clubs

WHEREAS, the Home Demonstration Clubs work toward more economic, social, civic and cultural improvement of the Puerto Rican housewives, and contribute effectively to the welfare of the family;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim the week from April 29 to May 5 as the Week of Home Demonstration Clubs, in recognition of their meritorious contribution to the welfare of the Puerto Rican family; and I urge the press, radio and television to join in this acknowledgment by making known their varied activities; I further urge the housewives who are not members of Home Demonstration Clubs to join them during this week.
