A PROCLAMATION

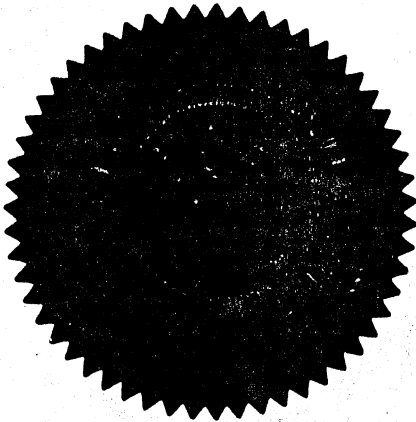
AN EMERGENCY CAUSED BY A HURRICANE

WHEREAS, On August 12, 1956, a hurricane hit the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, causing considerable damage to the roads;

WHEREAS, the damages caused to the roads have seriously affected the means of communication, thus creating a state of emergency;

WHEREAS, the immediate repair of the damages to the roads is necessary, so as to assure the general welfare;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ROBERTO SANCHEZ VILELLA, Acting Governor of Puerto Rico, do hereby declare that there is an emergency, and I deem necessary the immediate repair of our road system.
