
A PROCLAMATION

Veteran's Day, 1956

WHEREAS, we should dedicate a day in which to render special tribute to the heroes of the struggles for liberty in which our people have participated;

WHEREAS, we should broaden that day's significance by holding activities in honor of those living and dead veterans who so bravely fought for the preservation of the system of democratic life;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim Sunday, November 11, 1956, as Veteran's Day, and I urge our people to honor, through all possible means, our fellow-citizens who gave up their lives to preserve the ideals of peace and democracy, and to cooperate more fully during said day to the promotion of those same ideals; I also direct that during said day flags be displayed on all public buildings.
