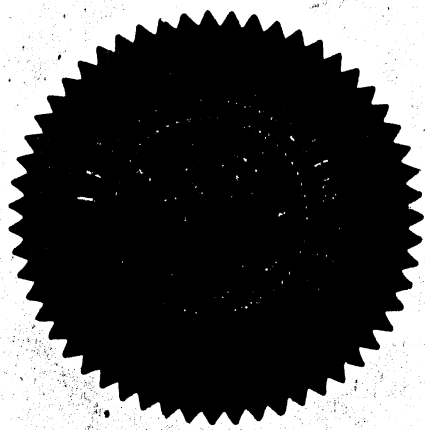
AN EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE
GOVERNOR OF THE COMMONWEALTH
OF PUERTO RICO

Inauguration of the Governor

WHEREAS, according to the terms of Article IV of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the Governor elected in the last general election shall qualify on the second day of January, 1957;

WHEREAS, it is proper that Puerto Rico should celebrate said event as a practical exercise of the democratic principles that govern our political activities.

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, by virtue of the authority conferred upon me by law, do hereby declare Wednesday January 2, 1957 a holiday and cordially invite all my fellow citizens to attend the inauguration ceremony to be held in front of the Supreme Court building during the morning of said day.



IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto

set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico to be affixed, at the City of San Juan, this 14th. day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-six.
