A PROCLAMATION

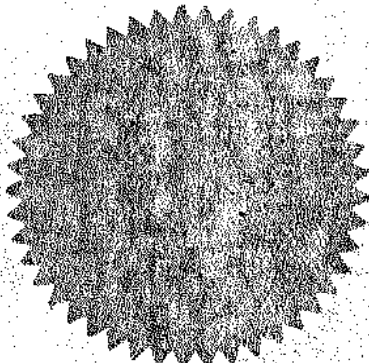
United States Constitution Day

WHEREAS, September 17th marks the anniversary of the signing of the Constitution of the United States of America;

WHEREAS, this document has a profound meaning for the entire democratic world;

WHEREAS, by establishing the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, giving a basis of freer and more dignified relations with the United States, the people of Puerto Rico on their own accord noted that the Articles of this document may be extended to Puerto Rico;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico do hereby proclaim Wednesday, September 17th as United States Constitution Day and I invite all of my fellow citizens in official and private capacities, to the utmost of their ability to tell and explain the principles embodied in the Constitution of the United States and honor the dedication to freedom and justice to which we are consecrated today.



IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico to be affixed, at the City of San Juan, this 26th day of August, A.D., nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.
