A PROCLAMATION

By the Governor of Puerto Rico

Call to Special Session of the Legislative Assembly

WHEREAS, there is a matter of public interest that requires action by the Legislative Assembly;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, by virtue of the authority conferred upon me by the Constitution, hereby call the members of the Legislative Assembly to a special session that shall begin on Monday December 15 in the Capitol, to consider the following matter and to adopt adequate means to attend to same:

TO AUTHORIZE THE SECRETARY OF THE TREASURY TO ANTICIPATE FUNDS TO THE SECRETARY OF LABOR TO CONTINUE THE PAYMENT OF COMPENSATORY SOCIAL BENEFITS TO WORKERS AFFECTED BY SHIPMENTS OF BULK SUGAR, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF ACT NO. 51, APPROVED JUNE 18, 1958.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the great Seal of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico to be affixed, at the City of San Juan, this 10th day of December, A.D., nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.
