A PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PUERTO RICO

SIGNING OF THE ZONING MAP OF DORADO

WHEREAS, having the Planning Board of Puerto Rico approved and adopted the "ZONING MAP OF DORADO" on October 28, 1959, pursuant to Act No. 213 of 1942.

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, under the provisions of Act No. 213 of 1942, hereby sign the code page of the "ZONING MAP OF DORADO", which shall take effect with all the force and effect of law thirty (30) days after the date of its exposition to the public in the City Hall of Dorado, making known to the public its approval and adoption, its exposition to the public, as well as the existence of the same in the office of the Secretary of the Board through the publication of an announcement for three (3) consecutive days in a newspaper of general circulation in the Island.
