A PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR OF THE COMMONWEALTH  
OF PUERTO RICO

WORKMEN'S ACCIDENT PREVENTION MONTH

WHEREAS, Labor accidents cause great human suffering to the Puerto Rican community, bringing physical and moral pain, orphanage and privations;

WHEREAS, the State Insurance Fund attends annually thousands of workers injured in Labor accidents, which represents a notable loss of millions of dollars;

WHEREAS, the Accident Prevention campaign that our citizenry develop with so much devotion throughout the whole year in Puerto Rico reclaims a period of greater dedication and enthusiasm;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, hereby declare the month of September, 1960 as "Workmen's Accident Prevention Month" and I recommend to all persons, government agencies and instrumentalities, as well as employers and employees, civic entities and federal agencies to develop an intensive campaign of human orientation and the economic necessity of reducing to a minimum all labor accidents, and to participate in the activities of the Puerto Rican Council of Workmen's Accident Prevention, thus contributing to the preparation of the human resources available to us, and so necessary to the economic development of the Island.
