A PROCLAMATION

United Nations Day, 1960

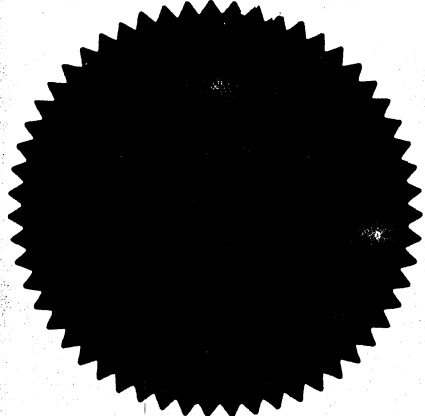
WHEREAS, the United Nations Organization, with its Specialized Agencies, is led by its principles to stimulate all countries to live in peace and neighborliness with each other, and to work together to improve the standards of living, food production, health, justice and education of all the world's peoples;

WHEREAS, the people of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico firmly support the United Nations Organization in its valuable work of promoting among nations a mutual respect for international law, for man's fundamental rights and for the free determination of peoples;

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico makes its modest contribution to the work of the United Nations through its Technical Cooperation and Cultural Exchange Programs;

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the United Nations has decreed that October 24, the anniversary of the coming into force of the United Nations Charter, be observed by making known in all countries the principles embodied in this historical document;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico do hereby proclaim October 24, 1960, as United Nations Day and I urge all public institutions and civic, cultural and religious entities, as well as the Press, Radio and Television, to dedicate their programs on that date to divulging the principles and purposes of this world organization so that the significance of this celebration may be clearly understood and appreciated by the Puerto Rican people.



IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico to be affixed, at the City of San Juan, this 29th day of September, A.D. nineteen hundred and sixty.
