A PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR OF THE COMMONWEALTH
OF PUERTO RICO

POINT SYSTEM

WHEREAS, Section 3-201-a-(3) of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of Puerto Rico, Act No. 141 approved July 20, 1960, empowers the Secretary of Public Works to suspend any driving license when the person authorized has a record of frequent convictions in the courts of justice;

WHEREAS, Section 3-204 of Act 141 authorizes the Secretary of Public Works to establish a point system or conviction rating plan to enforce the provisions of Section 3-201-a-(3), whereby points shall be accumulated against the drivers for each conviction of violation of the traffic-movement provisions of the law and its regulations;

WHEREAS, Section 13-206 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law provides that this system shall take effect as soon as the necessary regulations for its implementation are adopted by the Secretary of Public Works, and filed with the Department of State pursuant to Act No. 112 of June 30, 1957, and after the effective date is set through proclamation by the Governor.

WHEREAS, the regulations necessary have been duly adopted and filed;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ROBERTO SANCHEZ VILELLA, Acting Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, hereby proclaim February 1, 1961 as the effective date of the Point System.
