TRAFFIC REGULATION FOR THE URBAN EXTENSIONS OF STATE ROUTES
PR-111 AND PR-128 IN LARES, PUERTO RICO

Article 1- Authority

The Secretary of Public Works, by virtue of the powers vested on him by Chapter XII, Section 12-101 of Act. No. 141 (Vehicle and Traffic Law of Puerto Rico), approved July 20, 1960, promulgates the following Regulation:

Article 2- Application

The provisions of this Regulation shall apply to all types of Vehicles and their drivers using the Urban Extensions of State Routes PR-111 and PR-128 in Lares.

Article 3- Definitions

To the effect of this Regulation the following terms shall mean:

- a) Urban Extension of State Route PR-111, that part of Comercio Street included between Km. 35.40 and Hermita Street; plus Hermita Street; plus that part of Muñoz Rivera Street included between Hermita Street and San José Street; plus that part of this roadway included between San José Street and Stone Street; plus that part of this roadway included between Stone Street and Km. 32.97.
- b) Urban Extension of State Route PR-128, that part of this roadway included between Km. 38.10 and its junction with State Route PR-111.

Article 4- Direction

Upon the urban extensions of the State Route described in this Regulation, vehicular traffic may move in either direction except upon:

- a) PR-111
 - 1- That part of Comercio Street included between Méndez Street and Hermita Street, in which vehicular traffic shall move in one direction, only southbound.
 - 2- Hermita Street, in which vehicular traffic shall move in one direction only, eastbound.

Article 5- Parking Rules

Parking upon the urban extensions of these State Route shall be governed by the following rules:

a) PR-111

- 1-On that part of Comercio Street included between Km. 35.40 and Km. 35.50, parking shall be done according to the signs and markings placed by the Secretary of Public Works.
- 2-On that part of Comercio Street included between Km. 35.50 and Stone Street, no person shall park a vehicle upon the roadway side of the north curb.
- 3-On that part of Comercio Street included between Km. 36.70 and Stone Street, no person shall park a vehicle from 7 AM to 7 PM upon the roadway side of the south curb.
- 4-On that part of Comercio Street included between Stone Street and Hermita Street, no person shall park a vehicle upon the roadway side of the east curb.
- 5-On Hermita Street, no person shall park a vehicle upon the roadway side of the north curb.
- 6-On that part of Muñoz Rivera Street included between Hermita Street and San José Street, no person shall park a vehicle upon the roadway side of the west curb.
- 7-On that part of this roadway included between San José Street and Stone Street, parking shall be done according to the signs and markings placed by the Secretary of Public Works.
- 8-On that part of this roadway included between Stone Street and Km. 32.97, parking shall be done according to the signs and markings placed by the Secretary of Public Works.

b) PR-128

- 1-On that part of this roadway included between its junction with State Route PR-111 and Km. 38.10, parking shall be done according to the signs and markings placed by the Secretary of Public Works.

Article 6- Penalties


Any person who violates any of the provisions of this Regulation shall be punished according to the penalty provisions of Act. No. 141 (Vehicle and Traffic Law of Puerto Rico) approved July 20, 1960.

Article 7- Repeal

Allexisting traffic regulations or parts of traffic regulations inconsistent with the provisions of this Regulation, are hereby repealed.

Article 8- Time of Taking Effect

This Regulation shall have legal effect 30 days after being submitted to the State Department.
