

Section 1. To amend, Section 45-4-1

To amend, Section 45-4-1 of the Fishing Regulation approved by the Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico on July 11, 1984, to read as follows:

45-4-1


Dragnets, Bowlines, and Trammel nets, prohibited

Fishing is hereby prohibited in the rivers, lakes, ponds, lagoons and channels of Puerto Rico, with dragnets, bowlines and trammel nets, or any other similar fishing apparatus that this operation is necessary to throw from itself in an extensive water area, including a considerable quantity of aquatic life.

The Secretary may, upon just cause, permit the use of this fishing gear herein prohibited on specific ponds or rivers for the amount of time deemed necessary.

This amendmend will start to rule after been approved by the Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico and after its radication in the State Department, in accordance with Law No. 112, approved June 30, 1957, as amended, known as "Regulations Law of 1958."
