TRAFFIC REGULATION FOR THE URBAN EXTENSIONS OF STATE ROUTES PR-1,
PR-153, PR-538 AND PR-541 IN SANTA ISABEL, PUERTO RICO

Article 1- Authority

The Secretary of Public Works, by virtue of the powers vested on him by Chapter 12, Section 12-101 of Act No. 141, approved July 20, 1960, promulgates the following Regulation:

Article 2- Application

The provisions of this Regulation shall apply to all types of vehicles, to their drivers and passengers and to the pedestrians using the Urban Extensions of State Routes PR-1, PR-153, PR-538 and PR-541 in Santa Isabel.

Article 3- Definitions

To the effect of this Regulation the following terms shall mean:

- (a) Urban Extension of State Route PR-1, that part of Baldorioty Street included between Km. 104.25 and Celis Aguilera Street; plus that part of Celis Aguilera Street included between Baldorioty Street and Muñoz Rivera Street; plus that part of Muñoz Rivera Street included between Celis Aguilera Street and Km. 102.75.
- (b) Urban Extension of State Route PR-153, that part of De Hostos Street included between Muñoz Rivera Street (PR-1) and Km. 13.60.
- (c) Urban Extension of State Route PR-538, that part of Celis Aguilera Street included between Muñoz Rivera Street (PR-1) and Km. 0.30.
- (d) Urban Extension of State Route PR-541, Felicia #1 Road from Muñoz Rivera Street (PR-1) to De Hostos Street (PR-153).

Article 4- Direction

Upon the urban extensions of the State Routes described in this Regulation, vehicular traffic may move in either direction.

Article 5- Parking Rules

Parking upon the urban extensions of these State Routes shall be governed by the following rules:

(a) PR-1

- 1- On that part of Baldorioty Street included between Km.104.25 and Celis Aguilera Street, no person shall park a vehicle upon the roadway side of the north curb.
- 2- On that part of Celis Aguilera Street included between Baldorioty Street and Betances Street, no person shall park a vehicle on either side of the street.
- 3- On that part of Celis Aguilera Street included between Betances Street and Muñoz Rivera Street, parking shall be done according to the signs and markings placed by the Secretary of Public Works.
- 4- On that part of Muñoz Rivera Street included between Celis Aguilera Street and De Hostos Street (PR-153), parking shall be done according to the signs and markings placed by the Secretary of Public Works.
- 5- On that part of Muñoz Rivera Street included between De Hostos Street (PR-153) and Felicia #1 Road (PR-541) , no person shall park a vehicle upon the roadway side of the north curb.
- 6- On that part of Muñoz Rivera Street included between Felicia #1 Road (PR-541) and Km. 102.75, parking shall be done according to the signs and markings placed by the Secretary of Public Works.

(b) PR-153 (De Hostos Street)

- 1- On that part included between Muñoz Rivera Street (PR-1) and Betances Street, parking shall be done according to the signs and markings placed by the Secretary of Public Works.
- 2- On that part included between Betances Street and Felicia #1 Road (PR-541), no person shall park a vehicle upon the roadway side of the east curb.

3- On that part included between Felicia #1 (PR-541) and Km. 13.6, parking shall be done according to the signs and markings placed by the Secretary of Public Works.

(c) PR-538

1- On that part of Celis Aguilera Street included between Muñoz Rivera Street (PR-1) and Km. 0.30, no person shall park a vehicle upon the roadway side of the east curb.

(d) PR-541 (Felicia #1 Road)

1- Upon this roadway parking shall be done according to the signs and markings placed by the Secretary of Public Works.

Article 6- Penalties


Any person who violates any of the provisions of this Regulation shall be punished according to the penalty provisions of Act No. 141, approved July 20, 1960.

Article 7- Repeal

All existing traffic regulations or parts of traffic regulations inconsistent with the provisions of this Regulation, are hereby repealed.

Article 8- Time of Taking Effect

This Regulation shall have legal effect immediately after its publication, pursuant to the provisions of Act No. 112 of June 30, 1957, in the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico Register, for the purpose of which an original and two copies in both Spanish and English shall be previously filed in the Department of State Office.
