BY THE GOVERNOR OF PUERTO RICO A PROCLAMATION

Additional Ballots to vote on the proposed amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico

The following Resolution unanimously adopted by the Insular Board of Elections at a meeting held October 27, 1952, is hereby adopted.

"RESOLUTION


WHEREAS: On the day of the general elections of 1952 a referendum shall be held in which it shall be submitted to the approval of the people of Puerto Rico the two amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico proposed by the Legislature through Concurrent Resolutions No. 1 and 2 of the Senate and No. 1 of the House of Representatives, the three approved during the first special legislature of the first Legislature of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico;

WHEREAS: On said day each voter who attends the polls shall receive, together with the white ballot to vote for the candidates of his preference, two ballots to vote as he wishes on the referred amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, one ballot mammee color and the other canary yellow;

"NOW, THEREFORE: Be it ordained by the Insular Board of Elections of Puerto Rico:

- l.- That the three ballots mentioned should be handed to the voter attending any of the polling places, and said voter should receive the three ballots and go into the voting booth with the three of them, and after having voted, he is not to fold the three ballots together, but separately, and after having folded each of the three ballots separately, so that the clerks initials on the same are visible, he shall deposit, also separately, each of the three ballots in the ballot box.
- 2.- The poll inspectors and clerks should watch for the faithful observance of these orders.
- 3.- This Resolution shall be published in the press for the information of the inspectors and clerks and public in general, and a sufficient amount shall be printed so that a copy of the same will be available at each polling place.
 - 4.- This Resolution shall take effect immediately after the

date of its promulgation, as provided in Section 12 of the Election Law."
