

BY THE GOVERNOR OF PUERTO RICO A PROCLAMATION

Registration of electors of both sexes for the general elections of 1952

WHEREAS, Act Number 1 of the Fourth Regular Legislature of the Seventeenth Legislative Assembly, approved on February 13, 1952, sets Sunday March 16, 1952 for the registration of the electors of both sexes that have not registered for the general elections corresponding to the year 1952;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of Puerto Rico, pursuant to the provisions set forth in said Act, announce through this proclamation that Sunday the 16th of March, 1952, starting at one o'clock in the afternoon, registration shall take place in all the Island of Puerto Rico of all those persons of both sexes who have not registered, and who legally have the right to register to be able to vote in the general elections corresponding to the year 1952.
