BY THE GOVERNOR OF PUERTO RICO A PROCLAMATION


Children's Health Day, 1952

WHEREAS, by virtue of a Joint Resolution approved by the Congress of the United States in 1928, the first day of May has been set aside as Children's Health Day;

WHEREAS, infantile health has constituted and constitutes one of the main objectives of the Government of Puerto Rico;

WHEREAS, the health of children is essential for the continued progress of our productive capacity;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of Puerto Rico, do hereby designate the lst. day of May of this year, as Children's Health Day; and urge all official and private organizations interested in childhood to organize and celebrate in that day acts directed to show the people the importance of protecting and improving in all possible ways the health of the children of Puerto Rico.
