BY THE GOVERNOR OF PUERTO RICO A PROCLAMATION

National Farm Safety Week, 1952

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has designated the period of July 20 to 26 of this year, as Farm Safety Week;

WHEREAS, Puerto Rico is mainly an agricultural country, and the safety measures that are put into practice in the farm works will bring about promising results in the maintenance of the life and health of the worker, an increase in the products of subsistence and less cost in the production of the same with great benefits for our economy in general;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, VICTOR GUTIERREZ FRANQUI, Acting Governor of Puerto Rico, do hereby declare the period of July 20 to 26, as Farm Safety Week and urge all the people, and the corresponding agencies of the Insular Government to carry on an intensive divulgation campaign on the danger of farm work and the ways of preventing accidents among farm people. I further urge all federal farm organizations in Puerto Rico, and all farm organizations of this country to make known and observe the rules and precautions which mean a higher degree of security and protection for farm workers.
