
BY THE GOVERNOR OF PUERTO RICO A PROCLAMATION

To Declare July 25, 1952 a Legal Holiday, Date in which shall be proclaimed the taking effect of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico.

WHEREAS, on July 25, 1952 shall be proclaimed the taking effect of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of Puerto Rico, according to the provisions granted to me by law, do hereby declare July 25, 1952, a legal holiday, and during that day all public offices and commercial, industrial and professional establishments should remain closed.

I invite all citizens of Puerto Rico to attend the public festivities which shall take effect on that day to commemorate the establishing of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico.
