A PROCLAMATION


Farm Safety Week, 1953

WHEREAS, during eight consecutive years the Farm Safety Week has been observed in Puerto Rico;

WHEREAS, the greater number of farm accidents occur among the workers in the sugar cane fields;

WHEREAS, it is most proper that this celebration takes effect before the peak season of agricultural activities in order to maintain alert the safety consciousness of workers and employers, and to promote ahead of time the necessary measures to prevent accidents and needless waste of human resources;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby declare the week beginning February 8, 1953, as Farm Safety Week in Puerto Rico; and I recommend to all citizens, workers and employers organizations, Departments and organizations of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico and to the Federal Agencies related with agriculture, to carry out effective educational programs to teach the inhabitants of the rural zones how important and convenient is the elimination of hazards in the farms and rural homes and to put a stop to the loss and waste of manpower in the rural areas.
