A PROCLAMATION

National Employ the Physically Handicapped Week

WHEREAS, by virtue of Act No. 176 of 1945, the United States Congress designated the first week in October of each year as National Employ the Physically Handicapped Week; and

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has issued a proclamation enlisting public support for and interest in the employment of otherwise qualified but physically handicapped workers, inviting Governors, Mayors, and civic, social and religious organizations to give their support to such purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of Puerto Rico, do hereby declare the period from October 5 to 11, 1952, as National Employ the Physically Handicapped Week, and request from all public officials, municipal as well as insular, leaders of industries, educational, religious and civic groups, their cooperation and patronage for the purpose of obtaining the utilization and development of the capacities and aptitudes of the physically handicapped workers.
