A PROCLAMATION

Teacher's Day, 1954

WHEREAS, Act No. 70 of 1939 declares the first Friday of May of each year as Teacher's Day in Puerto Rico, and provides that the Governor shall issue a proclamation announcing said Day and recommending its observance;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Common-wealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby remind the public that Friday, May 7, is the date fixed by law as Teacher's Day this year, and invite all educational institutions to join in its observance through such activities and ceremonies as may be held for the purpose according to said law.
