A PROCLAMATION


Day of the Confined -

WHEREAS, the traditional generosity so characteristic of our people leads us to be interested in the ill, wounded and disabled confined to their homes, hospitals or other institutions;

WHEREAS, among these confined there are many members of the armed forces who have won our gratitude for their heroism in the battle field;

WHEREAS, we should urge the neighbors and friends of all those who are shut-in to carry on acts of congeniality and brotherhood which shall help alleviate their suffering, and to offer them spiritual consolation in their moments of sorrow;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim June oth as the Day of the Confined, and urge the people in general to aid in the purpose of remembering the sick, proffering them companionship, relief and consolation.
